In-class Exercise: Questionnaire Critique

Consider the following issues in critiquing each other's questionnaires:

1. Did the survey take too long?

2. Is the data useable? Can questions lead to variables that be quantified, compared, or related to one another?

3. Question format:

- Are choices in fixed alternative questions too broad?
- Are there any open ended questions that would be better as fixed alternative?
- 4. Were all the questions perfectly clear? Were there multiple ways to interpret any of the questions or possible choices? Explain.
- 5. Were you able to *easily* and *accurately* answer the all the questions? Did you have to "make a best-guess" for any questions?
- 6. Question order:
 - General questions before specific questions
 - Safe questions before questions on sensitive issues / controversial issues.
